ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution, Guru Nanak College of Education, Near Nehru Stadium, Bidar - 585401, Karnataka has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for one unit in B.Ed which require additional facilities.

3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found, that the institution has not shifted to its own premises as stipulated in its Formal Recognition order dated 30.11.2004.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC has decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall submit all documents including land, building, Encumbrance Certificate, Land Use Certificate, Building Plan, approved staff list, pertaining to shifting to own premises to the SRC before 31st July, 2015 failing which recognition will be withdrawn.
- II. The Regional Committees shall inspect the proposed premises during August-September-October, 2015 and if on inspection it is found that the institution does not fulfill required norms of infrastructure recognition will be withdrawn.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Guru Nanak College of Education, Near Nehru Stadium, Bidar - 585401, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students one basic unit from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at 4.(I) and 4.(II) herein before 31st July, 2015.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a chartered Accountant.

8. The institutions shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;

- g) Facilities added during the last quarter,
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and editions, if any, in the last quarter,
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Sri Nanak Jhira Saahib Foundation, Bidar, Karnataka had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Guru Nanak College of Education, Near Nehru Stadium, Bidar-585401, Karnataka for Secondary(B.Ed) Course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-05 with an annual intake of 100 students

On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired a land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has constructed a building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs 5 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs 5 Lakhs.
- d. The institution has selected the Principal and Seven lecturers for the said course and the list of faculty members has been approved by the affiliating University.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Guru Nanak College of Education, Near Nehru Stadium, Bidar-585401 Karnataka for Secondary(B.Ed) course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students subject to fulfilment of the following:

- a. The institution will ensure that Principal and Seven faculty members approved by affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to the effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.

- b The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
- c The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
- d The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the affiliating University, UGC, State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA



Sub: Grant of No Objection Certificate for establishment of Colleges of Education for the academic year 2004-2005.

- Read: (1) Government Order No. ED 20 URC 2003, dated: 29-04-2003.
(2) Government Order No. ED 20 URC 2003, dated: 02-06-2003.
(3) Letter No. GUG/ACA/AFFLN-3/2003-04/1315 dated: 23-10-2003 received from the Registrar, Gulbarga University, Gulbarga.

PREAMBLE:-

1) The State Government have lifted the ban on issue of *No Objection Certificates* for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges in all mediums of instruction from the academic year 2003-2004 in G.O dated: 29-04-2003. In G.O. dated: 02-06-2003, Mysore, Karnataka, Bangalore, Gulbarga, Mangalore and Kuvempu Universities were directed to advertise calling for applications for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges for the academic year 2003-2004 and to process the applications by following the procedures prescribed in section 59 of the Karnataka State Universities Act 2000 and thereafter to submit them to Government to enable it to consider for grant of NOCs under regulations 5 (e) of the NCTE Regulations 1995. It was clearly stipulated that while processing these applications, the norms and standards prescribed by the NCTE should be followed scrupulously.


2) Acting on this direction, the Universities have advertised calling for applications for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges and have processed the applications under section 59 of the KSU Act 2000. After completing the process, the Universities have submitted applications to the Government along with necessary documents.

3) Government have examined the recommendations received from the Universities keeping in view the number of existing BEd Colleges, their regional distribution/imbalance, the prolonged ban on establishment of teacher training institutions in the State, the demand for admission to BEd Course, the employment opportunities and also the future requirement of teachers in higher primary and higher secondary education sectors and various other factors incidental for taking a decision to grant *No Objection Certificates* for establishment of B.Ed Colleges in the State.

4) Hence the order.

5) Government of Karnataka are pleased to grant issue *No-Objection Certificate* to Sri Nanak Jhira Sahib Foundation, Udgir Road, Bidar, for establishment of Gurunanak B.Ed College, at Near Nehru Stadium, Bidar, offering B.Ed., course with an intake of 100 from the academic year 2004-2005 under Regulation 5(e) of the NCTE Regulations 1995, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) (No grant-in-aid shall be sought from Government for running the proposed college; it shall be subject to permanently unaided policy of the State Government. The institutions shall give an undertaking to Government to this effect at the time of sanctioning affiliation based on the recognition to be granted by the NCTE-SRC.
- (2) The institution shall provide adequate infrastructure, staff etc, as per the norms and standards, prescribed by the National Council for Teachers Education and also the affiliating University;
- (3) The institution shall abide by the orders/rules of the State Government and the statutes and regulations of the affiliating University issued from time to time with regard to admission policy and recruitment of staff to the institution etc;
- (4) The institution shall collect 'Tution fee' and 'Other fees' as prescribed by the State Government from time to time. The amount collected shall be utilized by the institution in accordance with rules.
- (5) The management should start the institution only after obtaining recognition from the National Council for Teacher Education under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993.
